



There are several restaurants in the vicinity of the villa, and a local village Bar where you can get food. There are many other places to eat out in the area, some from as little as 7 Euros per head. Want something more exotic? Murcia offers a wide variety of different cuisines, to suit all pockets.

There are five golf courses within easy reach of the villa. You will find details all in the villa. Golfers will require a current handicap card to play on courses in Spain. A new course has opened near Orihuela.



Shopping for food can be fun, as Fortuna, the nearest town, has a Saturday general market with fresh vegetables etc on sale each week. There are also several supermarkets in the town, plus a range of shops to cater for all your basic needs. All the shops are typically Spanish.

The coastal resorts can be reached in about 90 minutes and are well worth a day trip. Especially recommended are Alicante, Santa Pola and Guadamar de Segura.

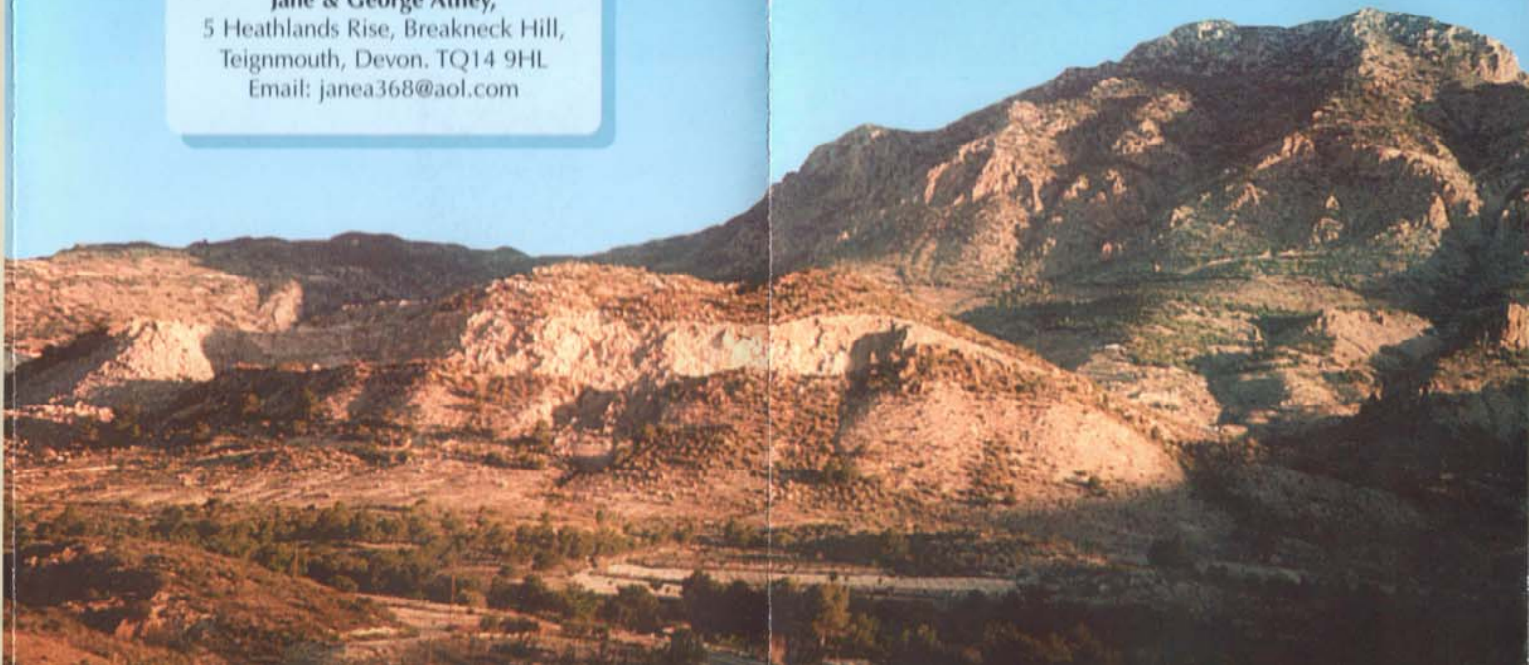

VILLA DEL OLIVO





This newly built villa, surrounded by mountains, is situated on the outskirts of the village of Las Casicas. The village is approximately 35 kilometres from the bustling city of Murcia and about 5 kilometres from Fortuna.

Fortuna is one of the most famous spa towns in Spain and the baths are only a short drive from the villa.

The villa is simply but tastefully furnished, has air-conditioning with



heater and has a traditional open stone fireplace for those early spring or autumn evenings. There are three double bedrooms, one en-suite and the other two with a shared bathroom and shower.

The kitchen is equipped with gas hob, electric oven, fridge/freezer, extractor fan and a good range of cupboards, including a fitted ironing board.

The utility room has a washing machine and houses the electric boiler. All rooms have beamed ceilings.

Outside, the garden features a mosaic swimming pool which is tiled all round, with steps down at the shallow end. There is a seating area for soaking up the sun or those al-fresco barbecue meals. The balcony faces west and the beautiful sunsets over the mountains are a delight.

Families with children are welcome but we regret that we cannot accept pets. Nor, at the present time, do we have disabled access.

A hire car is essential as the villa is situated in the mountain area of the Sierra de la Pila. This is approximately 80 km from Alicante Airport, but the route to the villa is easily followed.



Our prices include:-

1. Accommodation, as confirmed for the people on the booking form, including all local taxes, gas, water, electricity, service charges and swimming-pool maintenance (*where applicable*).
2. Bed-linen, towels and tea towels (*we do not supply towels for use in the swimming pool*) and weekly laundering of household linen.
3. Cleaning of the villa before your arrival and on your departure. However we would ask you to leave the villa in good order.
